## PASSENGER LOCATOR FORM: MANDATORY – BEFORE DEPARTURE

## **EXTRA-SCHENGEN FLIGHT**

Following a decision by Minister De Block – Minister of Social Affairs and Public Health – a mandatory form "Passenger Locator Form" is established. It's a health measure in the context of "contact tracing".

Every passenger, regardless of the nationality, who takes an Extra-Schengen flight to Belgium is obliged to complete this form before departure and to present it to the carrier. The form "Passenger Locator Form" exists now also in an electronic version. If the passenger has completed the electronic version, the passenger receives a QR code as proof that he/she has completed the "Passenger Locator Form". The "Passenger Locator Form" is automatically forwarded to the appropriate department. If it's not possible for the passenger to use the electronic version "Passenger Locator Form", the passenger is obliged to complete and sign the paper version "Passenger Locator Form".

If a passenger does not complete the "Passenger Locator Form", the airline is demanded to deny boarding.

If a passenger did not complete the "Passenger Locator Form" and boarded the plane, the Belgian authorities can refuse the access on the Belgian territory.

Please also indicate during the flight that a quarantine of 14 days is obliged in Belgium. *Remarque:* 

Passengers travelling from Bulgaria, Cyprus, Ireland, Croatia, Romania and the United Kingdom to Belgium are no longer required to go in a quarantine for 14 days.

If a passenger returns from a country with color code red, quarantine and a test is mandatory.

If a passenger returns from a country with color code red, quarantine and a test is mandatory. If a passenger returns from a country with color code orange, quarantine and a test are called for.

If a passenger returns from a country with color code orange, quarantine and a test are called for.

On arrival, the passenger must give the paper version "Passenger Locator Form" to the authorities competent for border control (Federal Police). This is part of the border control procedure.

Therefore, your company should not collect the form "Passenger Locator Form" on the aircraft, as the authorities competent for border control don't know if the passenger has completed the form "Passenger Locator Form".

The "Passenger Locator Form" will be available in 4 languages: Dutch, French, German and English.

The electronic version "Passenger Locator Form" will be available from 1 August 2020.

On arrival, the carrier must deliver immediately the paper version "Passenger Locator Form" to Saniport.
